# Speakers

**Martin O'Halloran** has been Chief Executive of the Health & Safety Authority since June 2007. He also served on the Board of the Authority from 1992 to 1995. Prior to joining the Health & Safety Authority, he worked in the telecommunications industry for more than twenty years. He has held senior positions with Telecom Eireann, Eircom & Vodafone. During this period he set up a number of joint venture companies & steered them through their early period. He currently serves on the Board of the Institute of Public Administration (IPA) & the Institute of Directors; is also a Chartered Director of Network Ireland & Chairman of the Association of Chief Executives of State Agencies. He is an honorary Vice President & Chartered Fellow of IOSH & a Chartered Director with the Institute of Directors.



**Dr. PJ Claffey** is a chemistry graduate from UCD. He has been working in the Health & Safety field for 30 years. He has worked in all areas of workplace regulatory enforcement & in particular in the chemical sector. Currently he has responsibility for managing the Authority's field enforcement programme. He has written relevant Irish Guidance on this topic including Guidance on Safety Statements and Risk Assessments, Health & Safety responsibilities for Directors & Senior Managers. He currently is a member of IOSH Ireland Branch Executive Committee & IOSH Council in the UK.



**Dr. Diarmuid Moran**, apart from a PhD in health physics & environmental radiation, has worked in the high tech sector as EHS Manager with well-established companies such as Seagate, Pfizer and Vodafone. He has prepared major emergency plans (transport and marine) & chemical & gas accident reports, business continuity / crisis management incidents while managing routine EHS & nationwide construction projects. CPD is a fundamental aspect of Diarmuid's career & he has qualifications from DIT, Trinity, FETAC, UCD, NEBOSH & NISO as well as



courses from Harvard (School of Public Health), DCU (corporate governance). Diarmuid mentors Engineers Ireland through his company Bowline Risk Management.

**Justin Burns** is currently an operational officer with Dublin Fire Brigade (DFB) & also the operations Director for Eirewater with specific responsibility for Health & Safety. He holds a MSc in Emergency Management and has been directly responsible for major projects including the DFB Operational Response Review & was also a co-author of the DFB Incident command system. He has acted as a professional and technical advisor on a number of European projects & exercises in places including the UK, Finland, Netherlands and Poland. He is a Fellow of the Chartered Management Institute and a Member of the Institution of Fire Engineers.

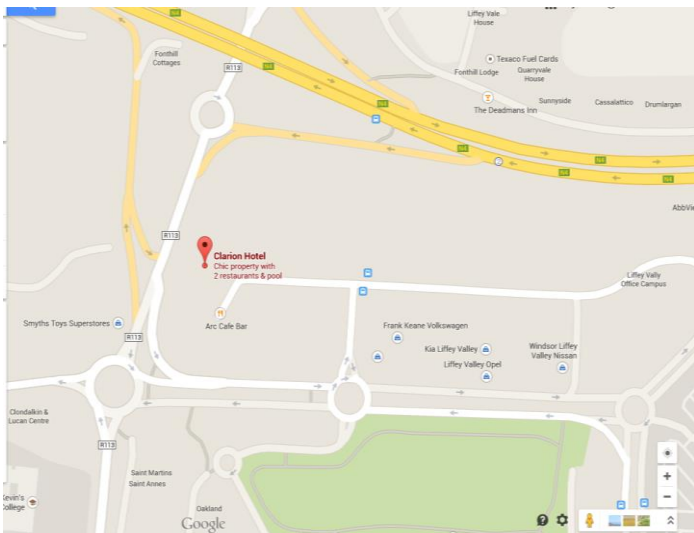
The speakers are experts in their fields and have proven diverse backgrounds which are sure to be of interest to all participants and stimulate both safety professionals and corporate managers.
